

Greece Public Library Unattended Child Policy

During library open hours:

Library employees cannot supervise children in the library. Parents or childcare providers have total responsibility for the behavior of all children they bring to the library.

Parents or childcare providers must remain in the library, and directly supervise children under the age of 11.

If a child under the age of 11 is left unattended in the library, staff will attempt to locate his/her parents. If parents cannot be contacted, the police will be called to supervise the child until parents can be reached.

After closing:

Staff are not permitted to remain after hours with an unattended child nor to give him/her a ride home. For the safety of the child, staff will not leave a child under the age of 11 after closing. If a parent cannot be reached by the time the library is to close, the police will be called to escort the child home or keep the child until parents can be reached.
