

## 3D Printer User Agreement

### Rules and Regulations

1. Users must be current Monroe County Library System cardholders.
2. Users must complete the library's 3D printer orientation session before submitting 3D files.
3. No weapons or weapon components will be printed using the library's 3D printer. Library staff reserve the right to reject print files.
4. Nothing may be printed that is not appropriate for a public library setting. Whether a print file is appropriate for a public library setting is at the sole discretion of the library director or her designee.
5. Permission to use the 3D printer may be revoked at any time at the sole discretion of the library director or her designee.
6. User agrees to comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations applicable to use of the 3D printer, including all copyright and patent infringement laws and regulations.
7. Library staff is available on a limited basis to assist in explaining operation of the equipment and will make available, upon request, materials such as manuals.
8. User agrees that Greece Public Library is not responsible for any manufacturing defects in the quality of workmanship or materials inherent in any of the tools or equipment.
9. User acknowledges that the library is only able to provide consumable materials on a limited basis, agrees to avoid wasting supplies and materials and will pay for such supplies.
10. User agrees to pay printing charge of .10 per gram, payable at the Circulation Desk upon pickup of finished product.

### 3D Printing Indemnification Agreement
