3D Printer User Agreement

Rules and Regulations

1. Users must be current Monroe County Library System cardholders.
2. Users must complete the library's 3D printer orientation session before using the 3D printer. Users under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a printer-certified parent or legal guardian at all times when using the printer. An orientation refresher with a library staff member may be required at any time.
3. Users must check in at the Information Desk, using their valid library card or photo ID when they arrive for their 3D printer appointment.
4. Last print job of the day must finish 30 minutes before library closing.
5. No weapons will be printed using the library's 3d printer. Library staff reserve the right to reject print files.
6. Nothing may be printed that is not appropriate for a public library setting. Whether a print file is appropriate for a public library setting is at the sole discretion of the library director or her designee.
7. Permission to use the 3D printer may be revoked at any time at the sole discretion of the library director or her designee.
8. User agrees to comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations applicable to use of the 3D printer, including all copyright and patent infringement laws and regulations.
9. Library staff is available on a limited basis to assist in explaining operation of the equipment and will make available, upon request, materials such as manuals.
10. User agrees that Greece Public Library is not responsible for any manufacturing defects in the quality of workmanship or materials inherent in any of the tools or equipment.
11. User agrees that if any piece of equipment becomes unsafe or in a state of disrepair, he/she will immediately discontinue use of the tool and notify library staff.
12. User is responsible for leaving the equipment in the same condition as originally issued and agrees to pay for any loss or damage incurred during the session.
13. User acknowledges that the library is only able to provide consumable materials on a limited basis, agrees to avoid wasting supplies and materials and will pay for such supplies.
14. User agrees to pay printing charge of .10 per gram, payable at the Circulation Desk at the end of the session.

3D Printing Indemnification Agreement

I/We have read and understand the Greece Public Library's 3D Printer User Agreement and hereby unconditionally and irrevocably agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Greece Public Library and the Town of Greece and their members, officers, trustees and employees from and against any and all claims, actions, causes of action, costs, expenses, liabilities or damages (including attorney's fees) of any kind or character suffered or incurred by any of them as a result of or arising from my/our use of the library's 3D printer service.

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
