

Greece Public Library Internet Policy

The Greece Public Library is dedicated to providing its visitors with the most current information available. Public access to the internet through library computers and wireless access points within the library is an extension of the library's goal of providing access to resources in a wide range of formats.

As a member of the Monroe County Library System (MCLS), the Greece Public Library provides public internet access through the MCLS automation system and adheres to the "MCLS Internet Access Policy Statement" (most recent revision 12/21/15). This policy statement includes language that "It shall be the policy of the Monroe County Library System to be in compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) and the Neighborhood Children's Internet Protection Act (NCIPA)."

Visitors use the internet at their own discretion. The library does not monitor nor can it control the content of the internet.

As with any library resource, parents and guardians are responsible for supervising their children's use of the internet.

Library visitors are expected to act in a manner consistent with all policies of the library, including the library's Code of Conduct. In accordance with federal and state laws and regulations, visitors are not permitted to access the internet in the library for any illegal or criminal purpose.

Because of the limited number of public access library computers, the library reserves the right to enforce rules to provide equitable internet access for all visitors. For current rules of use for public access computers and wireless access, ask at the library's Information Desk.
