

Greece Public Library Open Forum at Library Board Meetings Policy

Members of the public are welcome to attend Greece Public Library Board meetings. Library board meetings are for the conduct of library business. New York State's Open Meetings Law confers upon the public the right to observe the performance of public officials and attend and listen to the deliberations and decisions that go into the making of public policy. It does not give the public the right to speak or participate in board meetings.
